CYTOLOGY WORKING GROUP Project and Aims

Cytologic Grading of Well-Differentiated Neuroendocrine Tumors of Pancreas

- To determine the minimum number of tumor cells required for accurate grading of well-differentiated pancreatic neuroendocrine tumors (Pan Nets) on cell blocks prepared from fine needle aspiration (FNA) samples with comparison to corresponding resection specimens
- To determine the reproducibility of Ki-67 indices generated by the manual quantification methodology.
- Write a position paper regarding the best method and minimum number (if any) of cells required for accurate and reproducible calculation of Ki-67 indices on cytologic samples from Pan Nets.



CYTOLOGY WORKING GROUP Status of project

- Multi-Institutional study
- Data collection is complete
- Analyzed 143 paired cases of FNA and resected PanNET
- The data is undergoing statistical analysis
- Initial analysis shows a hot spot of 300 cells provides the best correlation
- The manuscript is in preparation

International Multi-institutional Retrospective Study of Pancreatic Ductal Adenocarcinoma Treated With Neoadjuvant Therapy: Validation of the AJCC 8th Staging System and Tumor Response Scoring System

- Led by Mojgan Hosseini
- 22 pathologists and 7 institutions from Asia, Europe and North American, including University of California-San Diego, Cleveland Clinic Foundation, The University of Alabama at Birmingham, Kagawa University, Massachusetts General Hospital, Heinrich-Heine University and University Hospital of Duesseldorf, and University of Michigan
- Five additional institutions are expected to join this large multi-institutional study this year.
- The preliminary analysis of 374 patients will be present at this USCAP meeting

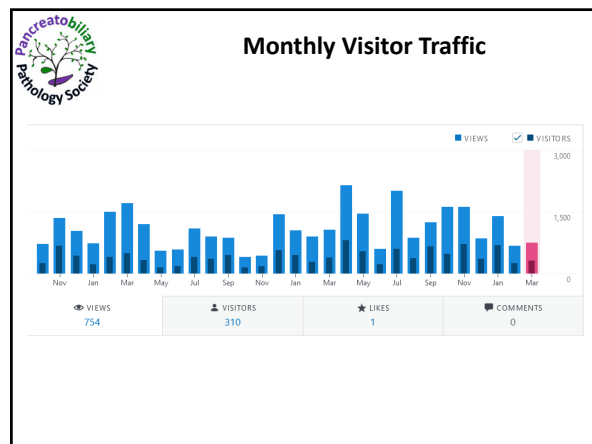
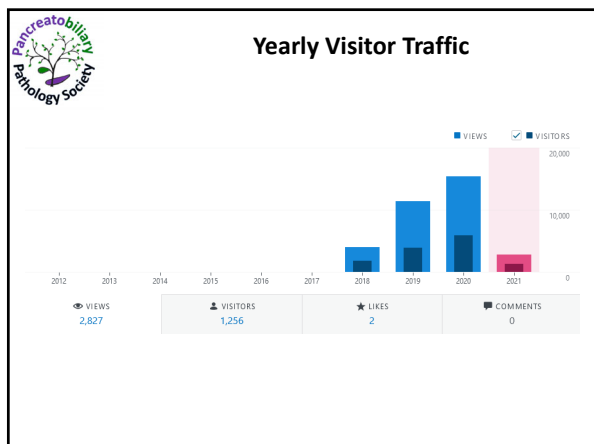

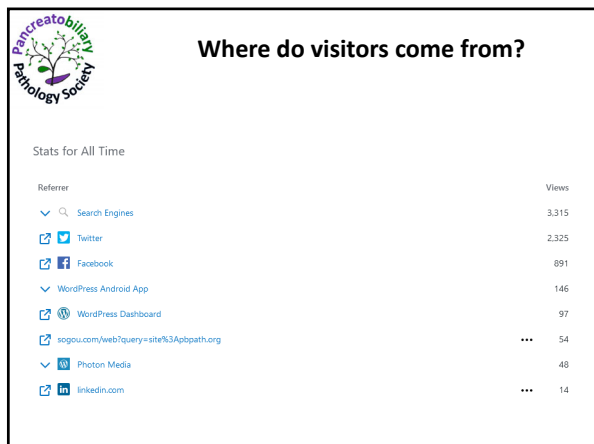
